

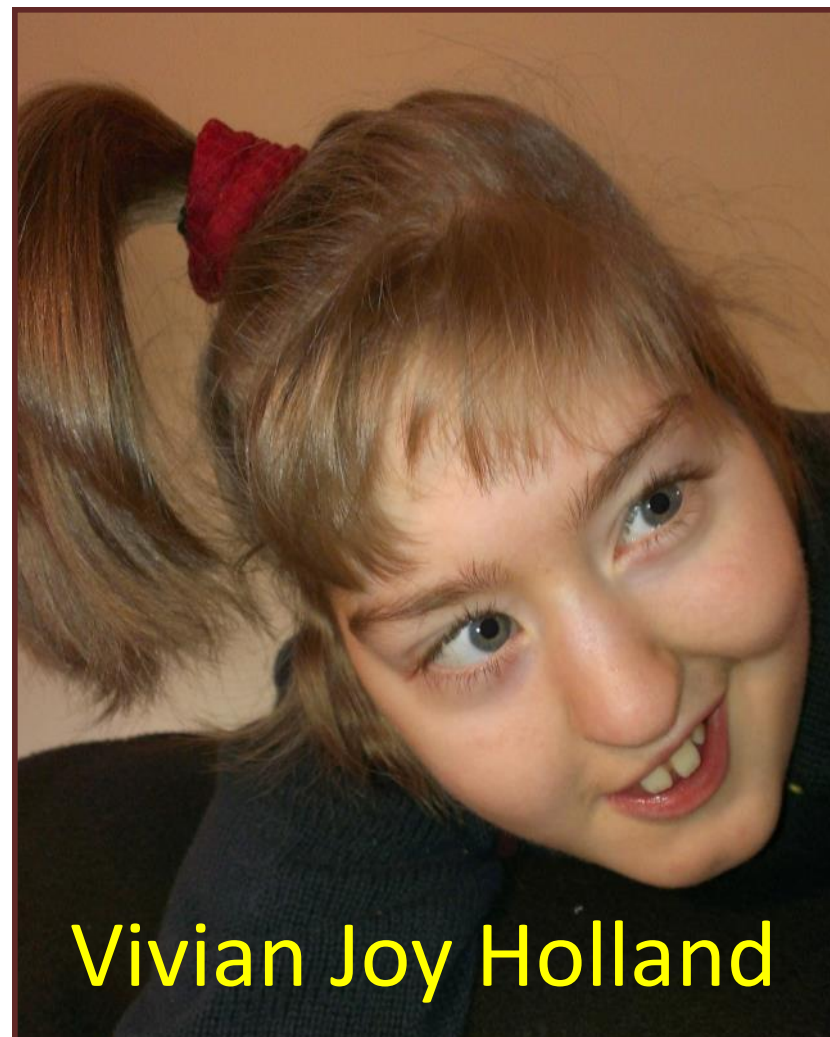
Vivian Joy
